The selected candidate is expected to have a solid commitment to teaching, a demonstrated expertise in one of the selected disciplines, and the ability to lead a vigorous, externally funded research program. The teaching duties include lectures and laboratory exercises, supervision of doctoral candidates and postdoctoral fellows, and participation in the Hevesy György Ph.D. School of Chemistry of ELTE. Active participation in R&D cooperation is strongly encouraged.
